Old Business/New Business		Old Business: Mandatory dues were discussed at most recent CKIA neighborhood meeting/town hall. Many questions were unanswerable unless/until more research is done. We likely need a committee of three (one for, one against and a neutral person.) Mary (last name) has offered to assist as she has a background/expertise in these areas; need someone to spearhead the project. Suggested that we offer another neighborhood meeting; give feedback from last meeting; announce that by the end of the meeting we would like to have a committee. It's recommended that we don't take questions again. We can review the questions that were asked; and answer those which can be answered.
