# President's Corner

#### Happy New Year Neighbors! I have the pleasure of serving as your Association president this year after 3 years in other officer capacities. My family has called Cherry Knolls home for 5 years and we love it. Our new board is a nice mix of new and long-time residents ready to continue the good work of our preceding boards. We also have a record number of neighbors volunteering on various committees. They are a motivated group and I'm privileged to work alongside them!

#### Among the regular business in December's meeting, I'd like to highlight a few items.

- The 2018 budget deliberations revealed that the requirement to maintain the \$400,000 investment in capital improvements (Cherry Park and Perimeter fence/ landscape) is increasingly commanding more of our operating budget. We cannot reasonably continue operations and the work on the long-range plan, as more and more funds are used for maintenance. Work on the Colorado/Nobles entrance was expected in 2018 but we're ~\$8,500 short of cost estimations (see budget on pg. 3) Our task is to explore income/expense options so we can continue routine operations, pursuit of the long-range plan, and be fiscally responsible to maintain existing improvements—not just this year, but to establish a plan for the long-term.
- 2018 marks the year in which we must consider whether any covenant changes are
  to be proposed or have the current version automatically extended for ten years.
  (Covenants Article 18 Duration). The board is mindful of its fiduciary responsibility
  to explore this with community input, so please watch for upcoming opportunities to
  participate and provide your voice to this important deliberation.

Finally, a big thanks to all those outgoing board and committee members last year; many of you continue to profoundly serve our community in other ways and we benefit daily.

# Cherry Knolls Home Improvemen

#### Featuring the Foa family on Easter Avenue.

Jason and Kory wanted to remodel their kitchen area with the desire to create a more open concept kitchen and to improve the lighting in this area. To help them with this project, they enlisted the help of Mark Piparato (Long Leaf Construction) and Jeni Finnigan (Unbounded Spaces).

Mark had to remove a structurally, non-supporting wall to open up the kitchen area, allowing for better flow of foot traffic. A u-shaped, ergonomically designed, elevated quartz island is central to their new kitchen. A 'mud room' was created at the entryway of the garage



for the removal of footwear and outerwear before entering the home. Upgrades were also made in cabinetry in the kitchen. Jason and Kory created a working computer station with visual access toward the front of their home within this living area.

Jeni provided design support with a focus on lighting. All new LED recessed can lighting and under cabinet lighting was installed throughout the kitchen. Three vintage globe pendants over the island and two more over the desk area were installed to further illuminate the room. She even added to the lighting plan a small directional recessed light to show off the industrial shelves Kory made and hung on the wall. Everything is on a dimmer to maximize the family's control. The light readings in the new kitchen are over double what they were in the old kitchen.

Mark Piparato has supported other upgrades in Cherry Knolls, including the Gilmore's kitchen remodel, and the Brumley's stair and mantel home improvements. Jeni has contributed toward improved home designs for the Dark's home on Easter Avenue.

As kitchens are where we spend much of our time within our homes, Kory and Jason were very pleased with their remodeled kitchen.
