# CK Governing Documents

**CKIA** governing documents are up for review this year. The Advisory Committee is taking on the task in accordance with the bylaws. The Committee proposes a two-step review process that may involve two voting opportunities by the membership:

- A May 2018 vote proposes amendment of the governing documents (last amended 1989-1999) to:
  - 1) update for legal conformity to Colorado State law and
- 2) simplify our legal structure and consolidate the six similar but separate covenant documents into one uniform Cherry Knolls covenant document.
- A potential May 2019 vote would address proposed amendments based on community input.

Why don't our governing documents comply with state law? We have been assured this is not unusual for older associations because state statute continues to evolve. Regardless of what our old governing documents say, CKIA and its members are subject to the current law so the Committee recommends the governing documents be updated.

Cherry Knolls has an overly complex legal structure with 8 legal filings that maintain six similar-but-separate covenant documents. This complex structure reflects the development as it was built section by section—not the one neighborhood we know today. Why is this important? Because proposed amendments like the legal updates (above) will require changes to six separate covenant documents and passage by the six separate covenant sections, which range in size from 14 to 248 homes. Crazy, right? This is why we are hoping to consolidate the covenant documents—so we will vote as one neighborhood and reduce costs in the future. This may involve minor tweaks to individual covenant documents, but essentially, the proposed document will reflect the one set of covenants we've commonly referred to as 'ours' located in the front of the directory and on the website. After 50 years, we can all agree that every home, from Harrison to Elizabeth and Briarwood to Easter, is part of one Cherry Knolls; the legal structure should reflect that. Specific language changes will be available on the website with proposed amendments in April.

# CK Governing Documents continued from page 1

The second and more time-consuming step is to find out whether Cherry Knolls residents want to change any of the current covenants. The rotary phone was the main form of communication when these covenants were written so it might be time to give them a 21st Century update. Two important notes: (1) The board will act as a neutral facilitator in this process to execute the community's desire to modify the current covenants. There are many covenant-related issues and none will be prioritized until the community considers all suggestions and the implied costs. (2) The pool (membership, facilities, etc.) will not be included because it is a separate legal entity. We want to make sure that all members have an opportunity to have their voices heard and will employ several methods to achieve that end. Look for information this fall in the newsletter and Nextdoor.com. If there is sufficient interest in making changes, we will target the May 2019 General Meeting for a vote.

Our goal in the process is to ensure the most important purpose of CKIA: the "promotion of friendly relations" among Cherry Knolls residents and the betterment of their general welfare. That is our charter and your board is striving to fulfill that mission. We look forward to your participation as we move through each step of this process.





# Construction has started in Willow Creek 1 and 2





## What's that smell?... The Cherry Knolls Park Pond

Cherry Knolls Park Pond is emanating a nasty stench, unusual for the pond. South Suburban Park and Recreation District (SSPRD) is addressing the issue, but that smell may get worse before it gets better. The stench is attributed to insufficient precipitation--the pond is not being adequately recharged with fresh water. In effect, it is stagnant this season. SSPRD treatment includes beneficial enzymes, aeration, and a recent tactic of pumping water from Big Dry Creek into the pond to circulate fresh water. That last step was just added and likely caused overflow back into the creek as well as an increase in bad odor. SSPRD indicated that the long-term goal is to dredge the pond. That, however, is a project that involves the Army Corps of Engineers and takes time to coordinate. So, hang in there, pray for moisture and try to breathe through your mouths for a bit longer:
