Centennial City Council Update

Thanks to everyone that attended the District 2 Summer Social at Cherry Knolls Park. There was great food, music and wonderful so see so many people in attendance. On August 13th we will host Centennial Under the Stars at the Centennial Center Park from 5 -10. There will be live music, laser show, food trucks and family activities.

We've heard from many of our citizens regarding the increase in homelessness in our City. The Council approved to pay for a Navigator through Arapahoe County that will be dedicated to the City of Centennial. The details are in the process of being completed and this person will work with our partners including South Suburban Parks & Recreation, South Metro Storm Water and Arapahoe Libraries to name a few to ensure we can help people find the resources they need.

If you haven't already, sign up for the Arapahoe Bridge updates to see how

the construction is going. They are in the process of pouring wingwalls as well as installation of the new storm sewer. Girders will need to be installed over night which will result in the closing of Arapahoe Rd. as well as Elizabeth St. Please continue to drive safely through this construction zone as the road configuration changes based on the work that is being completed.

Arapahoe Bridge Construction

Reconstruction of the bridge on Arapahoe Road, east of University Boulevard is underway. The existing bridge over Big Dry Creek was originally constructed in 1945 and is past its useful life. The Arapahoe Road Bridge project will replace the existing bridge with a wider and taller structure, improve pedestrian access over and around the bridge, and make improvements to the Big Dry Creek waterway. Construction is expected to be completed in 2023.

July construction has been on schedule and the new storm sewer construction will begin in August. Traffic restrictions on Arapahoe Road will continue and Elizabeth Street will be closed occasionally for construction. Detour routes for bikers and walkers are available on the City website. During these closures, traffic will be directed to use University, Colorado and Little Dry Creek rather than through Cherry Knolls. 

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Neighbors Create New Non-Profit




Cherry Knolls residents, Lindsey

This is the next installment of a series begun in our April issue featuring 1960s promotional materials and floor plans for various Cherry Knolls homes. In this issue we focus on one of Cherry Knolls' more distinctive home designs: one featuring a two-story entryway. Examples of this model can be seen in various locations in our neighborhood, still featuring impressive rock facings.

The "700" is actually one of the homes in our neighborhood not built by Branch-Writer. It was instead built by Lexington Construction Co.—which preferred to designate its house models by number—but to the same

high standards of craftsmanship and materials. (In fact, Branch-Writer designed a home that looked very similar to the 700: the Villa Nova.) The 700 came in "Contemporary" and "Colonial" designs and featured wood paneled family room with built-in bar, among many other cutting-edge amenities. It sold for \$25,900.


Some excerpts from the promotional materials: "Often sought ... Seldom found ... But here it is! Exciting in every aspect ..." "Ever see so much panel? And blended to just the right proportion, too!"


Finally: "A total of \$100.00 allowed for wallpaper and hanging." No, that's not a misprint: a Benjamin went a little bit farther back then.

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
